


Using Custom Table Renderer

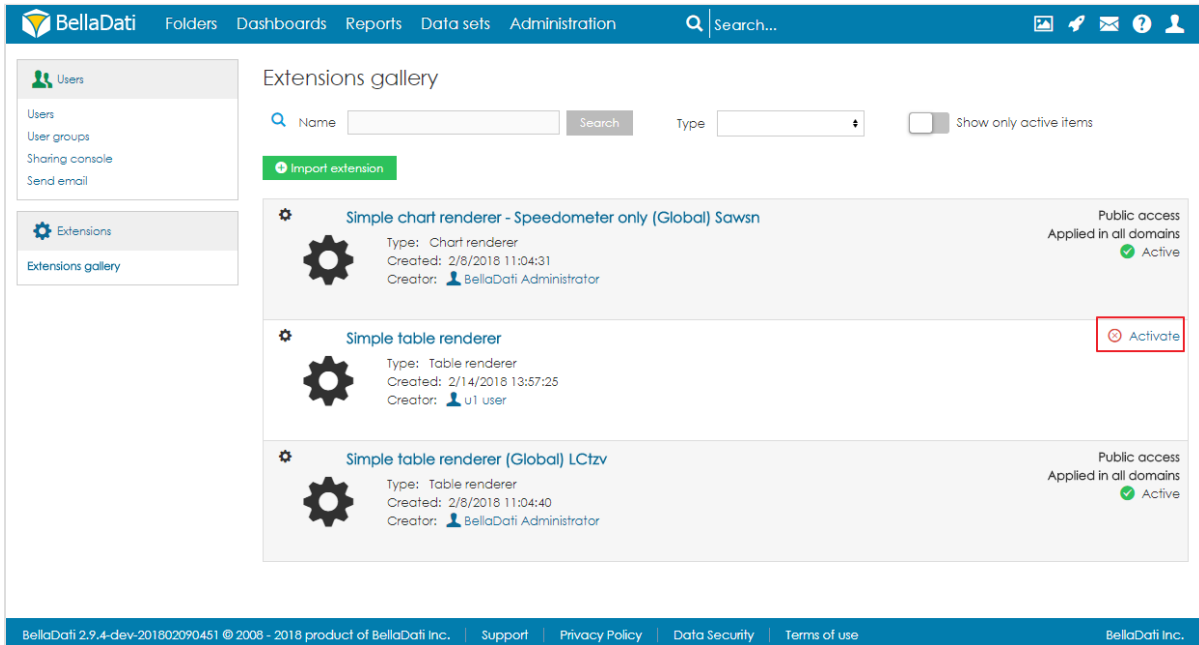
 This feature is available since BellaDati 2.9.4

It is possible to define a custom renderer which will be used to display a specific table. This renderer is defined in an extension. The user then has the option to select the renderer in table appearance settings.

Custom Renderer Setup

To be able to use custom renderer, user has to follow these steps:

1. Import an extension containing a custom renderer. You can download our demo custom renderer from [here](#).
2. Activate the extension.



Using Custom Renderer

Once the extension with custom renderer is activated, users can navigate to a report containing a table and select the renderer in table appearance settings.

1. Open report containing a table.
2. Open table appearance settings.
